Hailing from a small town on the west side of Norway, SJUR can already show to over 135 millions of streams with hit singles like *Let Me Love You*, *What Do I Do* and *Rich & Famous*. SJUR has positioned himself as one of the most exciting newcomers from Norway. After winning "Upcoming Electronic Producer of the Year" during the NRJ Music Awards in 2015, gaining write-ups on *Rolling Stone* and being #1 on *Hype* charts three times, SJUR released his first single on Sony in late 2016. *Let Me Love You* have since then gained over **90 million** streams on Spotify and been in the top 50 in Denmark, Sweden and Holland. Highlights

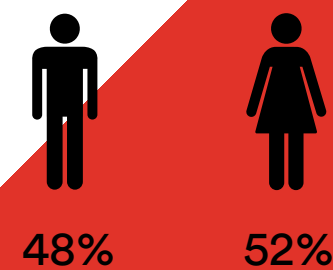

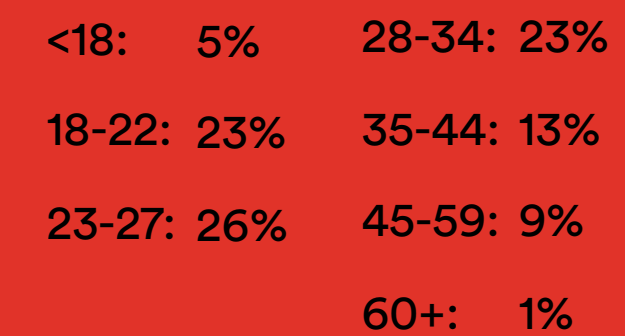
